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### **Charismatic**

*The charismatic speaker inspired the entire audience!  
Ravi is so charismatic that everyone listens when he talks!

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### **Uplifting**

US - /ʌpˈlɪf.tɪŋ/

*Making someone feel happier and more positive.*

*Priya shared an uplifting story that motivated everyone in class!  
The teacher's words were truly uplifting for struggling students!  
Isn't it uplifting when someone believes in your dreams?*

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### **Optimistic**

*Expecting good things to happen in the future.*

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### **Persevering**

## **Courteous**

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## **Magnanimous**

*The judge made a magnanimous decision to forgive the young offender!*

*Isn't it magnanimous to forgive someone who hurt you deeply?*

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## **Sincere**

*Genuine and honest in feelings or actions.*

*Ex:*

*Meera gave a sincere apology for her mistake!*

*Ravi showed sincere effort in completing the project!*

*How rare is it to find someone as sincere and genuine as Meera?*

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## **Radiant**

UK - /'reɪ.di.ənt/

US - /'reɪ.di.ənt/

*Shining or glowing with happiness or beauty.*

*Ananya looked radiant on her graduation day!*

*Riya's face was radiant after hearing her exam results.*

*Isn't it beautiful how happiness makes someone look radiant?*

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### **Resourceful**

US - /rɪ'sɔ:rs.fəl/

*Able to find smart solutions using available resources.*

*Arjun, who was resourceful, fixed the broken device using simple tools!*

*Neha is resourceful and always finds a way out of problems!*

*How resourceful can a person be in difficult situations?*

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### **Harmonious**
